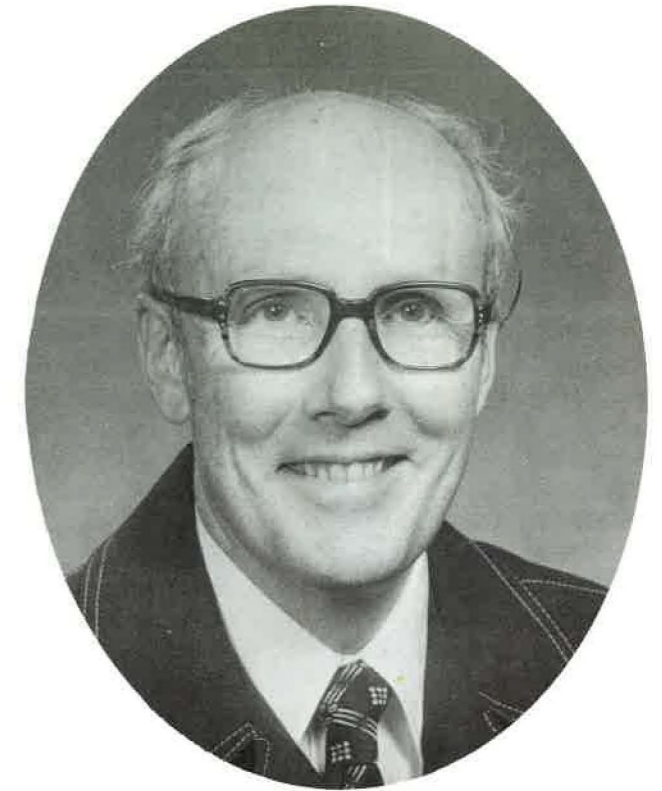

John H. Ryan Coordinator

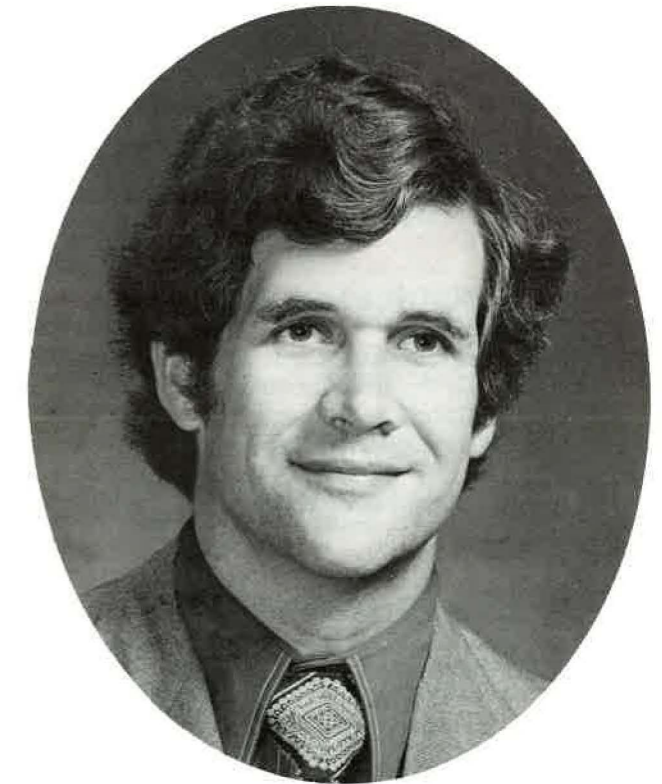
